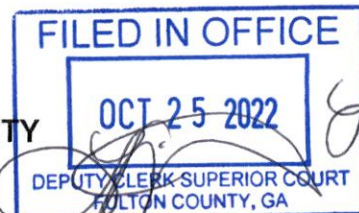

This Standing Order shall only apply to Misdemeanor Vehicle Homicide Actions with an incident date on or after October 24, 2022.

STANDING ORDER ON MISDEMEANOR VEHICULAR HOMICIDE ACTIONS
FILED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 24, 2022

Pursuant to Uniform Rules of Magistrate Court Rule 1.2(C), the court ORDERS that the following standing order and internal operating procedures apply to any case involving a Defendant in-custody for a Misdemeanor Vehicular Homicide charge filed on or after October 24, 2022.

The Court ORDERS that upon receiving a Misdemeanor Vehicular Homicide action through the jail, the State by the Solicitor General shall contact by email the parties responsible for first appearance identified below:

no later than 8:00 a.m. on the same date that the in-custody Misdemeanor Vehicular Homicide action appears on the jail calendar.

After the State has notified the parties above in accordance with this Standing Order, the action shall be placed on that day's **11:00 a.m. First Appearance hearing calendar** by the Clerk.

At the first-appearance hearing, the Magistrate Judge issues a bond and the case shall be bound over to the Clerk of the State Court.

This Standing Order shall only apply to Misdemeanor Vehicle Homicide Actions with an arrest date on or after October 24, 2022.

A copy of this Order shall be filed with the Standing Orders of the Court.
